2010 REGISTRATION

OUT OF COLORADO CAMPERS



Warmest Greetings! We hope to welcome your family to Colorado and to Geneva Glen Camp this summer! This information will explain enrollment for the 2010 season.

Attention!!! Geneva Glen Camp reserves 15% to 20% of its enrollment for out-of-state campers. Our sessions fill quickly and we hope to accommodate your first choice, however the session of your choice might be full. Please indicate a second and third choice if possible and choices for wait list(s).
Don't delay! Send your information in *right away!*

Registration Card: Complete ALL portions of the registration card (repetitions are deliberate, as a section is separated and given to the counselor).

- **SIGN** on part 3 of the card - or it will be returned to you.
- Be sure to indicate a second and third choice of session(s) and choices for the waiting list in case the session(s) you prefer is full. Your camper will be enrolled in your second or third choice before being placed on the waiting list.
- Confirmation of your enrollment and/or waiting lists will be mailed to you. Your confirmation card is your receipt. Allow a few weeks to process your registration.

Tuition and Deposit: \$1,575 per camper ages 6 - 16 for each two-week session.

- Each two-week session requires a **\$400** deposit per camper **now** and an additional **\$400** deposit by Thursday, February 11th, 2010.
- Final payment is due Thursday, May 6th, 2010.
- Tuition for the one-week Myths and Magic session is \$540 per camper age 6 - 8 and requires one \$100 deposit per camper due now.

Waiting List A \$50 deposit is required for each child on our waiting list (regardless of the number of sessions requested) and is fully refundable should your child not attend.

Important Note to Veteran Campers. Remember, Geneva Glen reserves places for out-of-state campers, however once Colorado families begin to enroll, the sessions will fill quickly- no matter how "veteran" you are, mail your card back NOW!! Keep in mind; you can cancel without penalty up to April 1st, 2010.

Myths and Magic Our specialty session for boys and girls, age 6, 7, and 8 years of age *only!* If we know you have a camper this age, information and a separate Myths registration card is enclosed. If you didn't receive any, and are interested in this session, contact us and we'll send you more information.

DEPOSIT AND CANCELLATION POLICY - - Please read carefully!

DEPOSITS:

- An initial **\$400** deposit is required for each two-week session for each child due when you submit your registration application. *Note that we will not process your registration application without the initial \$400 deposit check.*
- A second **\$400** deposit for each confirmed enrolled session is due by *February 11, 2010*
- For any enrollment after February 11, an \$800 deposit will be required.
- Myths & Magic requires one **\$100** deposit due when you submit your registration application.

CANCELLATIONS:

Applies only to confirmed enrollment. In order to accommodate our many wait-listed families as soon as possible, we adhere to the following policy:

1. ALL DEPOSITS WILL BE REFUNDED IN FULL IF WE RECEIVE A WRITTEN CANCELLATION NOTICE BY APRIL 1, 2010.
2. AFTER APRIL 1, 2010, ONE-HALF OF THE DEPOSIT (\$400) WILL BE REFUNDED IF WRITTEN CANCELLATION IS RECEIVED UP TO TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO YOUR ARRIVAL DATE.
3. WE CANNOT REFUND ANY DEPOSIT IF CANCELLATION IS RECEIVED WITHIN TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO YOUR ARRIVAL DATE. YOUR FORFEITED DEPOSIT CANNOT BE TRANSFERRED OR CREDITED TO ANOTHER CAMPER OR SESSION.

In February, we'll mail you transportation details, and the camp health form. Around mid-April, you will receive a statement showing session(s) enrolled, deposit received and balance due (by May 6) along with more "campy" information regarding clothing, check-in and check-out days, etc.

Points to remember:

1. **CHECK THE DATES FOR EACH SESSION.** Two-week sessions begin on Sundays (check-in on Sunday starts at 2:00 p.m.) and end on Saturdays (check-out on Saturday starts at 10:00 a.m.).
2. **ENCLOSE A DEPOSIT CHECK** with your registration for \$400 X # of children X # of two-week sessions, OR \$100 for Myths and Magic session.
3. **TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION** and airline guidelines (and your health form) will be mailed in February.
