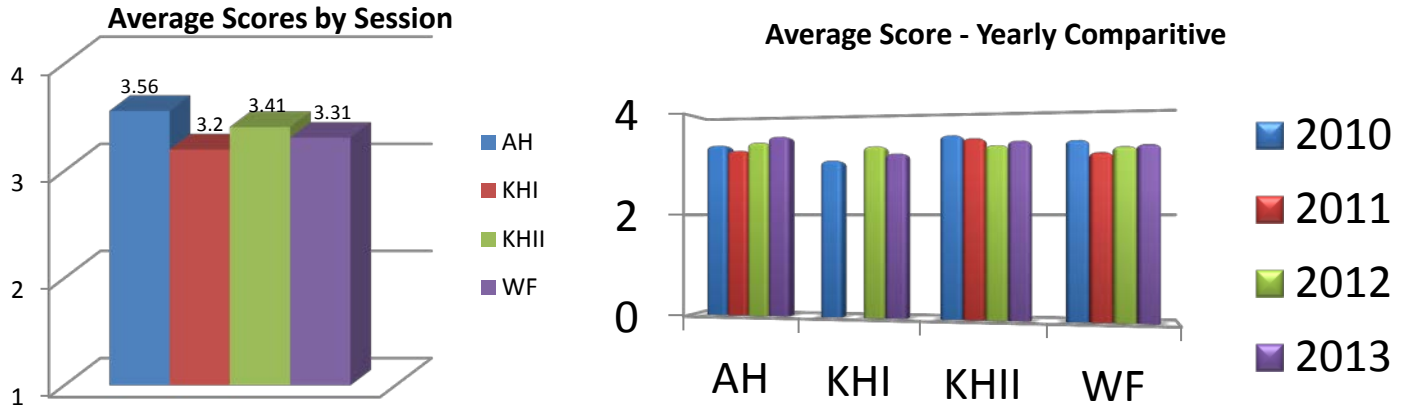


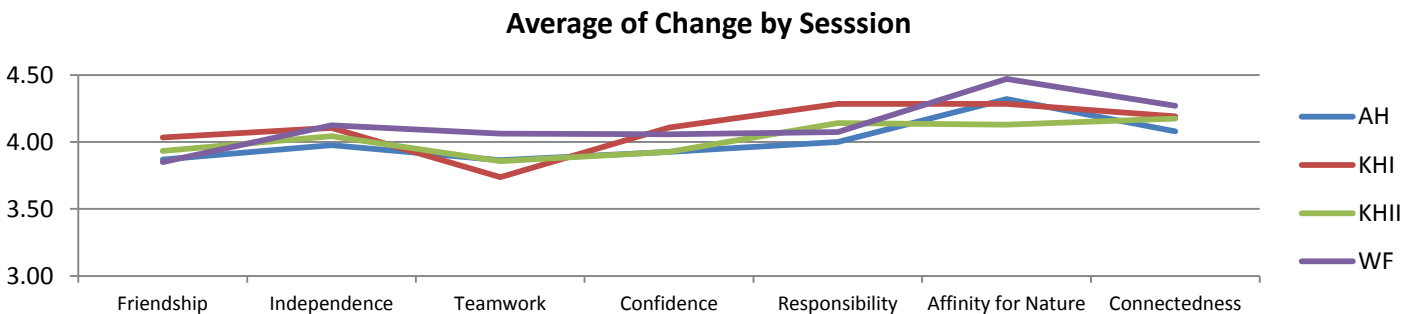
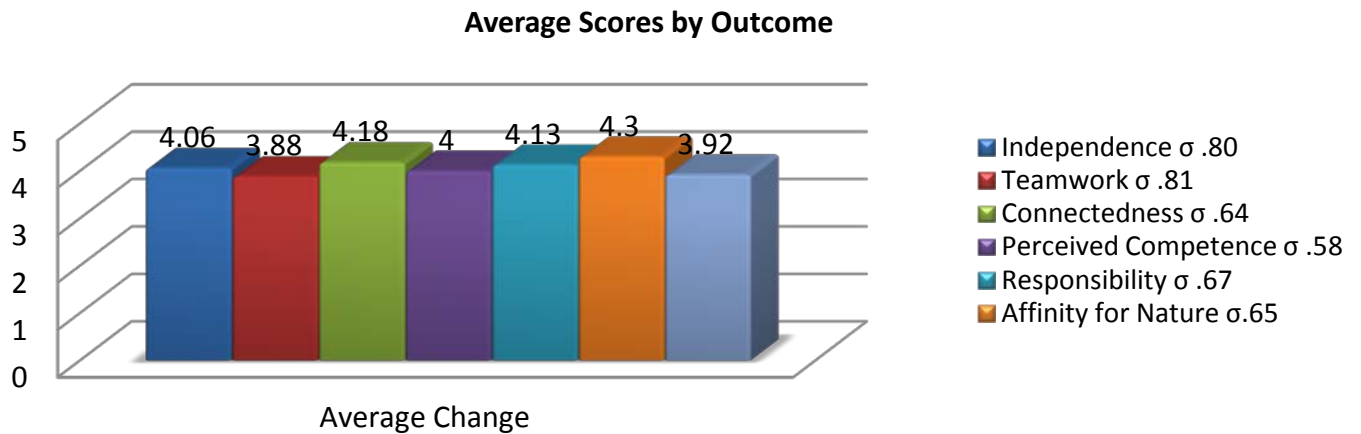

Basic Older Camper (Grade 6-8)

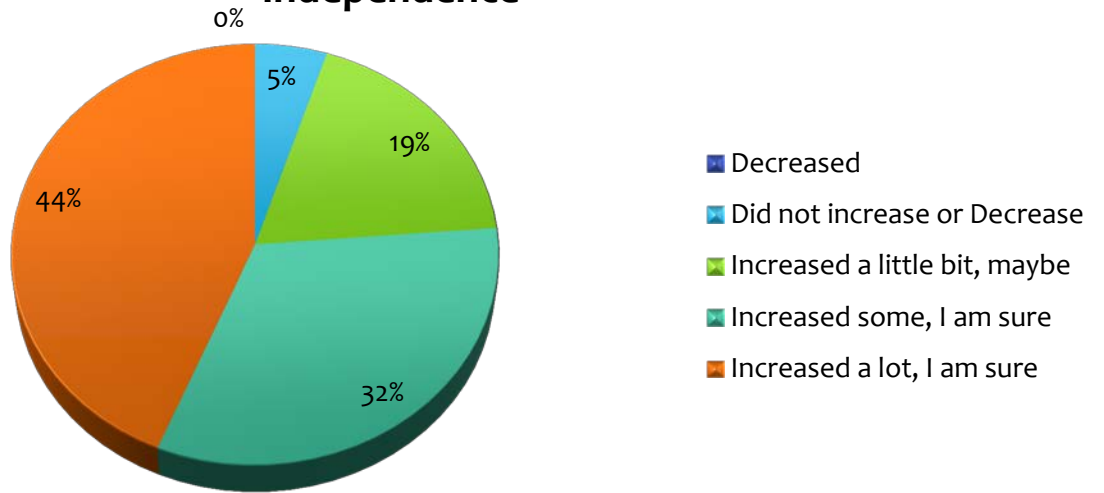


- World Friendship had the greatest effect on campers
- The average change in each outcome increases by year at camp
- Girls rated slightly higher than boys in every outcome (4 Years Now)
- Satisfaction Results (Scale 1-10): Mean 9.34 σ .90

What else should we know?

“Keep camp the same” or “It’s perfect the way it is.” **38%**

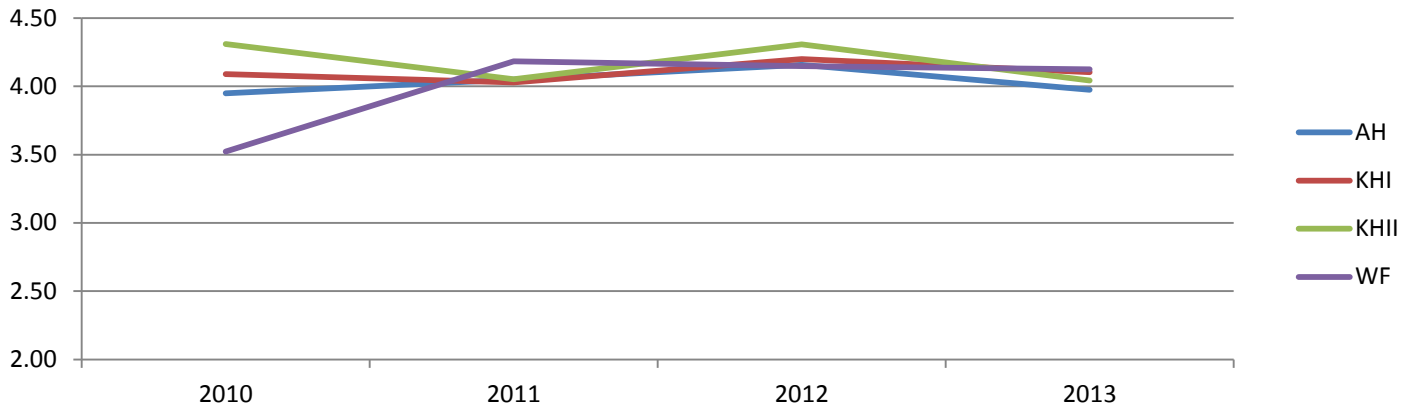
Independence



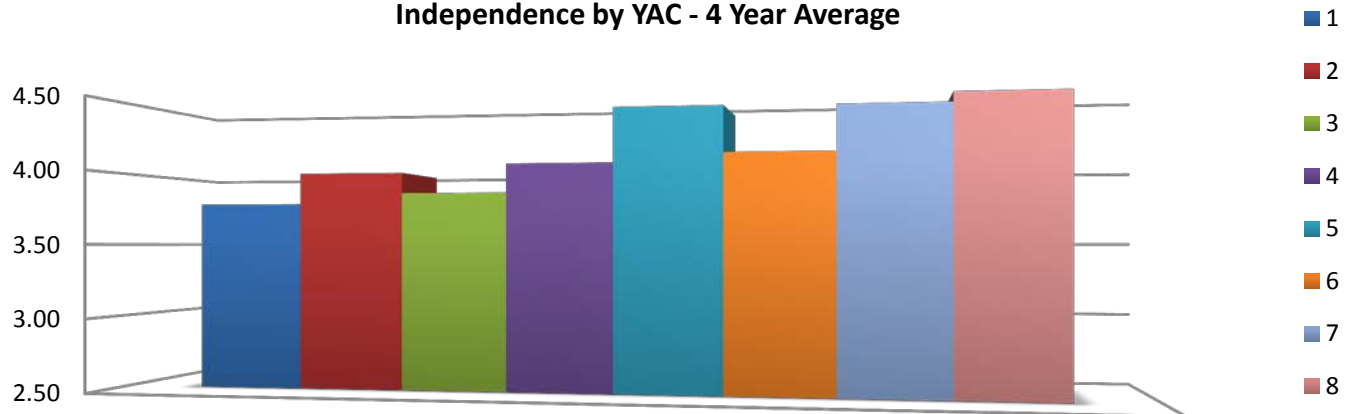
- Error in last 4 years of data analysis as a result of an error in the ACA Analysis Spreadsheet
- 95% felt that camp helped increase their independence (Even)
- Females score consistently higher than males (4 year average)
- ACA Normative Values: 60-70th Percentile

Mean: 4.06 σ .80

Average of Independence by Session

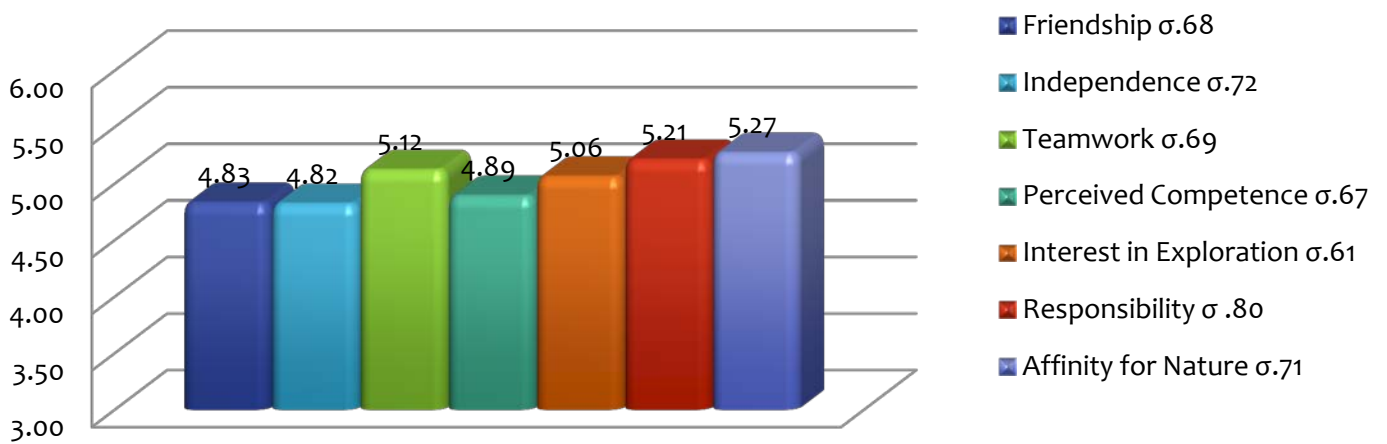


Independence by YAC - 4 Year Average

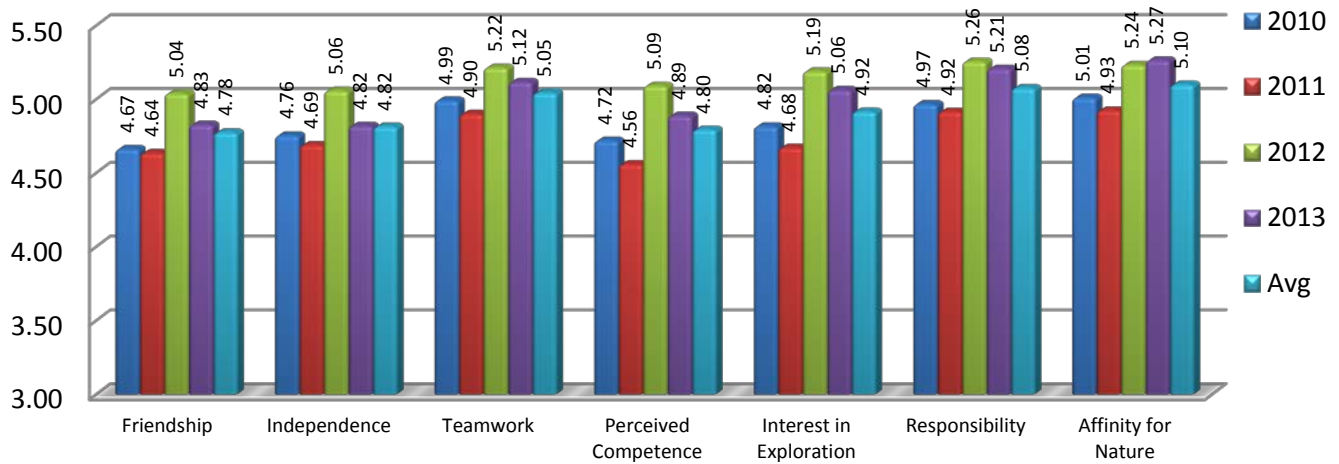

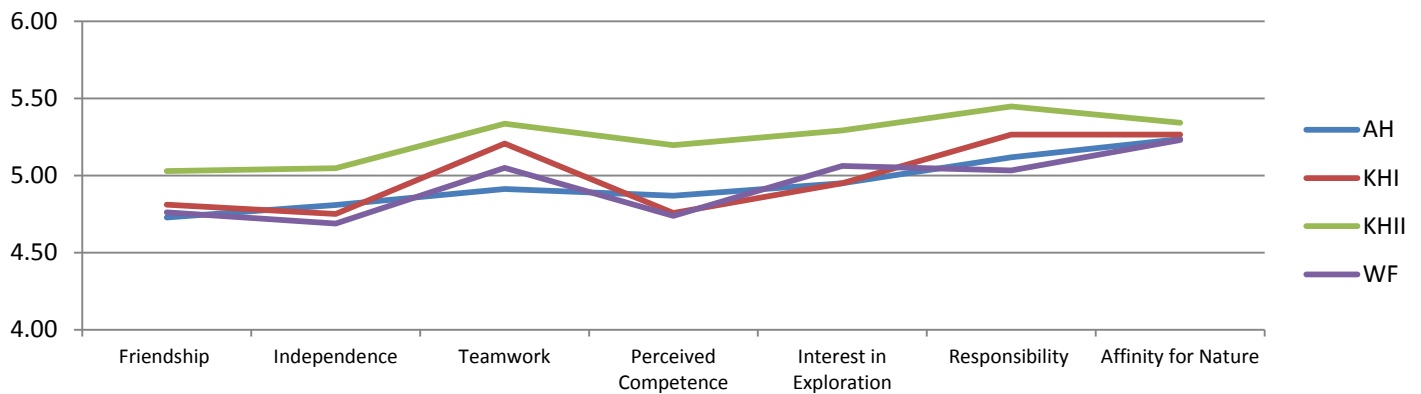
Average "Change" by Outcome

- Girls rated slightly lower than boys in both change and status (.2% change, .9% status)
- Knighthood II has the highest effect on campers
- Satisfaction Results (Scale 1-10): Mean 9.67 σ .54
